Low ropes

Our on site Low Ropes course is located in a beautiful sheltered woodland site on our property. It is aligned with the Adventure Activities Standards and comprises 8 separate elements that the activity coordinator takes small teams through. The activity encompasses individual challenges, sometimes taking participants outside of their comfort zone. Outcomes include; team building, decision making, trust and also a lot of fun. Elements include: spiders web, swinging log, tension traverse and swinging tyres.

High ropes

Off site and inclusive of transport to nearby High Ropes facility where all participants are briefed by instructors and required to don harnesses and helmets. While definitely taking participants out of their comfort zone, individuals all reach different levels of attainment. Awesome 3 hour activity.

Guided bush walk

Enjoy our many acres on a guided bush walk with our activity leaders. Varying levels of difficulty available, which can be ascertained with each group on the day and dependent on time allotted for your activity. Walks are between 1.4 kms and 6 kms long, and timed between 30 mins and 2 hours. Walks can also incorporate a morning or afternoon tea stop, or even a billy tea and damper.

Hike and abseil the Cathedrals

Transport is included from your accommodation to the Cathedrals where you are met by experienced guides who will lead the hike into the Cathedral Ranges and then abseil out. Holmesglen at Eildon can provide your takeaway morning and afternoon tea as well as lunch to match your day's activity.

Night walk and animal spotting

Great addition to the Hosted campfire, but can also be added to a mystery destination dinner (casual or formal) on the property or even a fondue at an onsite location, fireside or in summer outside with spectacular views of the night sky. Dependent on the group this can be combined with a sparkling wine and cheese stop or mulled wine.

Horse riding

On the edge of the High Country, this amazing ride is suitable for either beginners or the experienced, max group size per ride is 13. The ride starts just a short drive from our venue which we can coordinate with transport for your group if required. Lead by experienced horsemen, the ride takes you along creek beds and has magnificent scenery in the Rubicon Valley. Riding boots and helmets are included.

Bump it out

This high octane activity is guaranteed to get the blood pumping as teams or individuals battle it out in a series of fun games. Each 'Bump It Out' activity is very interactive, hilarious to watch and play and requires minimal skill to have fun.

Giant foosball

More difficult ride, based on the Pondage ride that is extended to include a longer ride over the Eildon Dam wall. This incorporates harder terrain including a hill climb.

Australian bush and farm experience for young or old.

Welcome to Country

Lead by our local Indigenous Elder, 'Welcome to Country' is a fantastic way to start or finish a conference or group stay. It is especially enjoyed by international guests. Delegates are welcomed to the land and participate in the smoking ceremony at one of our camp fire locations either adjoining the main building or in the bush near our Recreation precinct.

Ochre painting, bush tucker, boomerang throw

Join our indigenous team and learn about indigenous culture. This can be offered as a full morning or afternoon session including all components, or maybe just choose to do ochre painting and decorate a canvas and/or a boomerang. The ground ochre may be taken home as a souvenir. (1.5 – 3 hours)

Hosted campfire

Great way to get your group or teams together after dinner with a relaxing hosted campfire. This can also be combined with a night walk with spotlights on the property as you enjoy the quiet of the bush, our local wildlife and star studded skies. Combined with billy tea and milo, toasted marshmallows and either traditional damper or even cooked in the coals - baked chocolate bananas. Your campfire hosts will lead conundrums, campfire stories and a sing a long.

Ferreting

Small groups only and not for the feint hearted – but great opportunity to see how they use ferrets to trap the ever increasing population of rabbits in the bush. Group are transported to a location on the 660 acre property. If successful in capturing any rabbits the group can also learn how to skin and prepare a rabbit for cooking (not in our commercial kitchen). Their successful catch can be cooked in the camp oven down at the Rec precinct later that night for supper.
