Laser clay target shooting and/or Archery

Clays flying overhead, the sound of shotgun blasts, your team cheering as you score a direct hit! Laser clay target shooting is a fun, totally safe and interactive spin on clay pigeon shooting using modified shotguns that fire a harmless infrared signal. Or you can participate in the ancient form of medieval weaponry called Archery. Either way your team will have an absolute blast!

African drumming

Segway team challenges

Connect with nature and love the Australian outdoors.

Lake Eildon boat cruise

Discover one of Victoria's largest man-made lakes, Lake Eildon. Step aboard the purpose built touring boat, "Missy", as she navigates the immense shore line and expanse of the lake. Enjoy the peace of the lake, with sunlight rippling through bordering mountains and fresh air straight off the water. Look out for local wildlife in the National Park. Or create a festive atmosphere on board with music and fun.

Guided bush walk

Enjoy our many acres on a guided bush walk with our activity leaders. Varying levels of difficulty available, which can be ascertained with each group on the day and dependent on time allotted for your activity. Walks are between 1.4 kms and 6 kms long, and timed between 30 mins and 2 hours. Walks can also incorporate a morning or afternoon tea stop, or even a billy tea and damper.

Bike riding

Easy guided bike ride around the beautiful Eildon Pondage, perfect for those that want a flat terrain ride with photo opportunities. Suit beginner riders as well.
(2 hours including transfers to Pondage)

More difficult ride, based on the Pondage ride that is extended to include a longer ride over the Eildon Dam wall. This incorporates harder terrain including a hill climb.
(3 hours including transfers to Pondage)

Hike and abseil the Cathedrals

Transport is included from your accommodation to the Cathedrals where you are met by experienced guides who will lead the hike into the Cathedral Ranges and then abseil out. Holmesglen at Eildon can provide your takeaway morning and afternoon tea as well as lunch to match your day's activity.

Night walk and animal spotting

Great addition to the Hosted campfire, but can also be added to a mystery destination dinner (casual or formal) on the property or even a fondue at an onsite location, fireside or in summer outside with spectacular views of the night sky. Dependent on the group this can be combined with a sparkling wine and cheese stop or mulled wine.

Adventure learning in a beautiful bush setting.

Canoeing

This is a great activity as an introduction to canoeing for all groups. Skills are taught and games played to assist those participating to overcome their fear of water and canoeing. Our Rainbow Dam at Holmesglen is in a picture perfect setting and each session accommodates a maximum group size of 16. Helmets and Personal Floatation Devices (PDFs) are provided, even wetsuits and footwear for those who require them. Participants enjoy the beauty of the location and fun team building experience.

Giant foosball

The popular table game foosball has now been made into a life-size, inflatable, fun experience. This game is very interactive, hilarious to watch and play and requires minimal skill to have fun. What makes it so popular is that it can literally be enjoyed by anyone. Players don't need any special sporting skills or athletic abilities. Each participant puts on a waist harness enabling them to only move from side to side or left to right just like the popular table soccer game. The teams have to overcome these restrictions by synchronising their movements. Teamwork and communication are essential to pass the ball successfully between team members so teams can score.

Construct it, Raft build challenge

The program starts with teams battling it out in a number of team challenges to win points, that will enable them to bid at the auction to win additional equipment to make their water safe vessel even more sea worthy, capable of sailing to victory. Team challenges consist of activities such as Giant Jenga, Crack-Up, Catapults, Sprung a leak, Meteor Shower and more!

Once the rafts have been constructed the teams must pick a crew and approach the starting line where it will become apparent that team cooperation is the major strategy. Teams must now paddle for line honours, with their team-mates shouting encouragement. The race is always a source of plenty of laughs and gives teams a chance to develop team spirit as they barrack for the crew of their raft.

Scavenger hunt

In small teams you explore and endeavour to find answers and clues hidden on the property. A fun participatory challenge for all to be involved on-site. Approximately 1 – 2 hours.

Australian bush and farm experience for young or old.

Welcome to Country

Lead by our local Indigenous Elder, 'Welcome to Country' is a fantastic way to start or finish a conference or group stay. It is especially enjoyed by international guests. Delegates are welcomed to the land and participate in the smoking ceremony at one of our camp fire locations either adjoining the main building or in the bush near our Recreation precinct.

Ochre painting, Bush tucker, Boomerang throw, Basket weaving

Join our indigenous team and learn about indigenous culture from members of the Taungurung people. This can be offered as a full morning or afternoon session including all components, or maybe just choose to do ochre painting and decorate a canvas and/or a boomerang. The ground ochre painting, boomerang or basket weaving may be taken home as a souvenir. Approximately 1.5 – 3 hours.

Hosted campfire

A hosted campfire is a great way to bring your group together. This can be scheduled as part of a dinner option that features pot roast and baked apples etc. Or it can be an after dinner singalong. A campfire can be combined with a night walk with spotlights on the property as you enjoy the quiet of the bush, our local wildlife and star studded skies. Add billy tea, milo, toasted marshmallows, damper or chocolate bananas for a memorable night. Your campfire hosts will lead conundrums, campfire stories and even include some guitar playing!

Ferreting

Small groups only and not for the feint hearted – but great opportunity to see how they use ferrets to trap the ever increasing population of rabbits in the bush. Group are transported to a location on the 660 acre property. If successful in capturing any rabbits the group can also learn how to skin and prepare a rabbit for cooking (not in our commercial kitchen). Their successful catch can be cooked in the camp oven down at the Rec precinct later that night for supper.

Varingo, where bingo meets pop culture

Varingo combines pop culture, music, movies and trivia into one exciting bingo game. Players receive a Varingo mystery card which is much like a classic bingo card but instead of traditional numbers, they'll find things like song and movie titles on the card. When players hear the song or watch a clip from a movie on their card, they cross it off their card. When they complete two full lines on the card, they win Varingo! Examples of a Varingo round consist of hit songs from the 60's to today, box office hit movies and famous faces such as actors, musicians, sports people or political figures. Rise and Fall, a game of strategy and leadership

The program begins with teams participating in a fun activity challenge, which determines whether they rise or fall. Teams progress through the next challenge and use their decision making, teamwork and problem solving to plan how they make the next step. Teams participate in fun challenges such as River Crossing, Traffic Jam, Blind Waiter, Frisbee Frenzie, Olympic Relay and more!
